Job Summary: The Electrician/Installer will be responsible for the installation of Fire Alarm systems, Security Systems, CCTV, Kitchen Appliance Shutdowns, Access Control and Voice/Data Cabling.

- Installation and termination of copper and fiber-optic cables
- Installation of support structure for cable systems
- Installations dealing with conduit, wire pulling
- Review new project information with lead technician

- Telephony experience a plus
- Must have a solid understanding of the National Electric Code and NFPA 72
- Fire Alarm system installation a plus
- Ability to work with little or no supervision
- Ability to read and understand blueprints
- Knowledge and experience dealing with electricity from 12v-240v
- Understanding of electric contactors, coils and relays
- Organizational skills – ability to plan and coordinate your work
- Must be a team player
- Ability to lead a crew and make decisions
- Ability to operate scissor or aerial lifts
- Ability to work flexible hours, weekends and/or overtime when required
- Submit accurate and timely documentation to your immediate supervisor (Billing reports, Data entry information).
- Ability to adapt to change with little advance notification
- Must have reliable transportation, valid driver's license and clean driving record
- Ability to Pass background checks and Drug and Alcohol Screenings
